

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.
Avoid breathing vapours and spray.
Wash exposed skin thoroughly after handling.
Contaminated work clothing should not be allowed out of the workplace.
Wear protective gloves, eye and face protection.
Avoid release to the environment.

FIRST AID MEASURES

INHALATION: Keep patient calm, remove to fresh air. If breathing difficulties develop, aid in breathing and seek immediate medical attention. In case of unconsciousness, place patient on side for transportation. Seek medical treatment in any case of complaints.

SKIN: Remove and isolate contaminated clothing, shoes, and leather goods immediately and take a shower. Rinse affected areas with non-abrasive soap or mild detergent and large amounts of running water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Get medical help if irritation or rash develops and persists.

EYES: Rinse eyes cautiously with clean running water for at least 15 minutes, while holding eyelids apart. Remove contact lenses after 5 minutes if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing while holding eyelids apart. Direct contact with eyes can cause irritation. Seek medical help if irritation continues.

INGESTION: If swallowed, rinse mouth, DO NOT induce vomiting, unless instructed to do so by poison control centre or doctor. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Product is harmless if swallowed in small amount. Get medical help if you feel unwell.

HANDLING AND STORAGE

Safe handling: Ensure thorough ventilation of stores and work areas.
Storage: Store in original container. Containers should be stored and tightly sealed in a cool, dry place, between 5 – 35 °C. Protect from freezing. Avoid prolonged storage of opened containers.

Disposal of used containers: Emptied containers can be washed with soap and water. Dispose of in a licensed recycling or refuse facility. Crushing, puncturing or other means to prevent unauthorized use of used containers, recommended.

GENERAL

Amarillo does not dry and is not washed away by water. Undercover **Amarillo** remains sticky for 3 – 6 months. In open areas or when exposed to heavy dust, **Amarillo** will lose its stickiness faster. The sticky surface can be renewed by applying another layer of **Amarillo** over the previous layer. **Amarillo** does not contain organic solvents or pesticides.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

(Use only as directed)

- Apply 80 – 100 mℓ per m² by spraying (Teejet nozzle 8003), brushing or rolling on polyethylene sheets stretched between poles, or any smooth surface.
- Do not add water. The product is ready to use.
- Clean application equipment immediately after use with soap and water. Do not leave product in spray equipment.
- Avoid spraying into the wind.
- Do not spray above shoulder height.

- Moenie bo skouer hoogte spuit nie.
